If you have questions you can call our main line at 758-5730. We look forward to welcoming you to the new location.

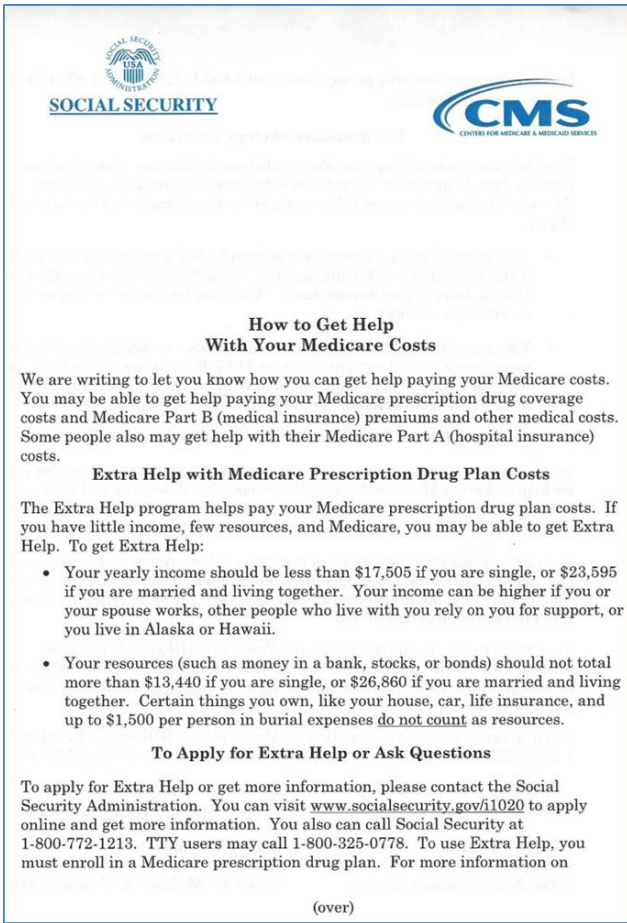
On-Line Auction for Surplus Items

This is a "sealed bid" auction, so only one bid per person is allowed. Auctions items are available for one month, opening the first day and closing at midnight on the last day of the month. There are many good items offered for sale.
