## Commercial Waste

The following wastes generated from commercial entities hauling their own trash should be brought directly to the landfill.

**Disposal Rate - \$31.05 per ton:**

- Construction Rubble
- Concrete/Asphalt
- Carpeting
- Wood Pallets
- Scrap Wood
- Mixed Waste
- Wire/Cable
- Paper/Plastic/Cardboard
- Clean Brush & Stumps
- Agricultural Waste
- Ash, Dirt or Sod
- Non-friable Asbestos
- Mobile Homes that fit on scale
- \$300 flat rate for Mobile Homes that DO NOT fit on scale.

**Note:** It is the responsibility of the contractor to obtain a written quote for the cost of disposal services.

**Special Handling Rate:**

**\$10.00/yard** (\$10.00 minimum)

- Bury Records

**Friable Asbestos:** Call for disposal rates and requirements.

## Hazardous Materials that are accepted daily:

*Waste motor oil~Batteries~Antifreeze~Propane bottles  
Motor oil and antifreeze must be in plastic containers  
no larger than 5 gallons*

## Miscellaneous Items Accepted:

### APPLIANCES / METAL

*The landfill accepts appliances and metals for recycling  
Refrigerators must have doors removed before  
leaving at landfill.*

### COMPOSTABLES

*The landfill accepts the following compostable materials :*

*Grass clippings • Pine needles • Leaves  
Weeds & hay • Branches & limbs*

**Clean stumps without dirt and rocks**

### JUNK VEHICLE

*Free removal of Junk Vehicles*

### TIRE DISPOSAL

*Enviro Tire - 755-7716*

### FUEL TANKS / BARRELS:

*Call for disposal information*

### PHARMACEUTICALS (PILLS ONLY - NO LIQUIDS)

*There are receptacles for pills at the following locations:  
Flathead County Sheriff's Office foyer  
City of Columbia Falls Police Station  
City of Whitefish Police Station*

## Household Hazardous Waste Sign Up

### WHAT IS HAZARDOUS WASTE?

It is any substance that has the potential to injure people, pets or the environment through skin contact or ingestion. Hazardous waste is in your kitchen, basement, garage, shop or greenhouse.

Examples:

Oil base paint, thinner, solvents, adhesives, stains, cleaners, furniture stripper, ammonia, pesticides, herbicides, insecticides, poisons, fertilizers, tree sprays, fuel carburetor cleaner, flea powder, lye, turpentine . . .etc.

Many items like these can be taken for granted. But if they are not used properly as instructed on the label, or used completely, they have the potential to cause harm to you,

They don't belong laying around!  
They don't belong in the greenboxes or landfill!  
They shouldn't be dumped out!

Take them to the FREE Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day held the third Saturday of every month.

- **DO NOT MIX WASTES**
- **ACCEPTING ORIGINAL, CLEARLY MARKED CONTAINERS ONLY**
- **NO BARRELS**
- **NO LATEX PAINT** (Hardened latex paint can be thrown away in the regular trash.)

### TO PARTICIPATE:

Send us a completed Household Hazardous Waste registration form and we'll mail back a post card with your appointment time.  
**(Only morning appointments are available.)**

### WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT THE LANDFILL:

Proceed to the Hazardous Waste building and present your card to the staff. Please stay in your vehicle, our staff will do the unloading.
