

COLUMBIA FALLS CITY-COUNTY PLANNING BOARD AND ZONING COMMISSION

The Columbia Falls City-County Planning Board and Zoning Commission is made up of nine members - four representing the city, four representing the county and a representative from the Soil Conservation District. In the event there is no member or associate member of the Conservation District who is able or willing to serve on the board, the ninth member must be selected by the eight officers and citizen members of the board, with the approval of the Board of County Commissioners and the City Council. The term for the representative from the Conservation District would run from January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013.

There is one (1) county position which will become vacant at the end of the year. The two-year term will run from January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2014. All county positions are appointed by the Flathead County Commissioners. There is also one county position that remains vacant from last year. That term will begin January 1, 2013 and run through December 31, 2014.

To be considered for a county position the applicants must reside within the planning jurisdictional area but outside the city limits of Columbia Falls.

WHITEFISH LAKE & LAKESHORE PROTECTION COMMITTEE

The Whitefish Lake and Lakeshore Protection Committee, a citizen advisory board, was formulated to have advisory jurisdiction over all of Whitefish, Lost Coon and Blanchard Lakes for issuance or denial of permits for lakeshore projects.

The Committee is made up of seven voting members, three representing the city, three representing the county and a Member-at-Large selected by the Whitefish City-County Planning Board. A professional staff planner from the Whitefish Planning Office shall serve as an ex-officio, non-voting member. At least two of the appointees shall be residents on Whitefish or Lost Coon Lake.

There is one (1) county position which will become vacant at the end of the year. The position is for the Blanchard Lake Representative. The opening is a three-year term beginning January 1, 2013 and will run through December 31, 2015.
