NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Board of Commissioners of Flathead County, Montana, hereby gives notice pursuant to Section 76-2-205(1), M.C.A., that it will hold a public hearing to consider a request by the Roman Catholic Diocese of Helena, to change the zoning designation in portions of the Bigfork Area Zoning District from AG-40 (Agricultural) and AG-20 (Agricultural) to AG-20 (Agricultural) and SAG-5 (Suburban Agricultural).

The proposal would change the zoning on 41 acres. The proposal would change the zoning from AG-40 and AG-20 (Agricultural) to AG-20 (Agricultural) on the westerly 20 acre portion and it would change the zoning from AG-40 and AG-20 (Agricultural) to SAG-5 (Suburban Agricultural) on the easterly 21 acre portion. The subject property can legally be described as a Tract of land in the NW1/4 of Section 13, Township 27 North, Range 20 West, P.M.M., Flathead County, Montana (shown as Parcel A of Certificate of Survey No. 12910). The property is located at 195 Coverdell Road.

The proposed change would generally change the character of the zoning regulations applicable to the property from those intended to protect and preserve agricultural land for the performance of a wide range of agricultural functions, intended to control the scattered intrusion of uses not compatible with an agricultural environment, including, but not limited to, residential development, to regulations intended to protect and preserve smaller agricultural functions and to provide a buffer between urban and unlimited agricultural uses, encouraging concentration of such uses in areas where potential conflict of uses will be minimized, and to provide areas of estate-type residential development. The AG-40 classification has a minimum lot size of 40 acres and AG-20 has a minimum lot size of 20 acres; a change to SAG-5 would result in a minimum lot size of 5 acres.

The regulations defining the AG-40, AG-20 and SAG-5 Zones are contained in the Flathead County Zoning Regulations, on file for public inspection at the Office of the Clerk and Recorder, Courthouse, temporarily located at 1035 1st Avenue West, Kalispell, Montana, at the Flathead County Planning and Zoning Office, 1035 1st Avenue West, Kalispell, Montana, and on the Flathead County Planning and Zoning Office's website, at: http://flathead.mt.gov/planning_zoning/downloads.php. Documents related to the proposed zone change are also on file for public inspection at the Office of the Clerk and Recorder and the Flathead County Planning and Zoning Office.

The public hearing will be held on the **21st day of December, 2011, at 10:00 o'clock a.m.**, in the Office of the Board of Commissioners of Flathead County, Courthouse 3rd Floor, Kalispell, Montana. At the public hearing, the Board of Commissioners will give the public an opportunity to be heard regarding the proposed change in the regulations for the described portion of the Bigfork Area Zoning District.
