Walt Bastiaanse, KM Ranch Road said he understands that if 51% of the parcel owners on the road disapprove or approve that will be the direction the RSID goes. He questioned how that would work if only 30% of the residence participate in the vote. He also asked if the residence pay 30% of the improvement costs if they would have any rights as to the design of the road or to control what kind of traffic is allowed on the road. Bastiaanse said they would be buying 30% of the county road and questioned if that would give them anything other than pavement.

Commissioner Krueger stated the Road Department would determine signage and so on and future commissioners could determine what signage might be put on there through a process. He explained the RSID protest process is set up by state statute and that is what is followed by the county.

Walt Bastiaanse clarified then that the only vote they would have is to protest.

Pence explained that there are 153 lots that would be divided by two. He noted the commissioners can pass a Resolution of Intent to form the RSID and that is what could be protested out.

FLATHEAD COUNTY SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS**

The Board of Commissioners of Flathead County, Montana, hereby gives notice, in accordance with Section 76-3-503, M.C.A., that the Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing to consider revisions to the Flathead County Subdivision Regulations, adopted pursuant to Section 76-3-501, *et seq.*, M.C.A. Proposed deletions are noted with a strike-through whereas proposed additions are noted in *italics*.

**4.5 Subdivisions Created For Lease or Rent**

4.5.1 General (Pg. 26)

A subdivision created for rent or lease, including ~~but not limited to~~, manufactured home parks, and recreation vehicle parks, ~~or campgrounds~~, is any tract of land divided by renting or leasing portions under single ownership. Proposed subdivisions created for lease or rent must be under single lot or parcel and subject to these Regulations. Any subdivision created for lease or rent which is converted to condominium use must be reviewed pursuant to Section 4.6 (Condominiums).

4.5.7 Recreational Vehicle Park ~~and Campground~~ Standards (Pg. 29)

All recreational vehicle parks ~~and campgrounds~~ shall comply with the following standards in addition to the requirements of Section 4.5.5:

4.7.17 Roadway Improvements (Pg. 45)

All road improvements.....

a. All internal subdivision roads *shall be paved*, with the exception of secondary emergency roads. ~~shall be paved~~. *Internal roads within 'recreational vehicle parks' may or may not be required to be paved, dependent upon whether or not the preliminary plat review identifies potential adverse impacts from dust can be adequately mitigated through the imposition of conditions aimed at minimizing or eliminating impacts from dust;*

4.7.20 Water Supply Systems (Pg. 49)

All water supply systems.....

e. *For subdivisions with a shared, multiple user, or public water supply system the subdivider shall provide a statement of whether or not the system will be a public utility as defined in 69-3-101 and subject to the jurisdiction of the public service commission or exempt from jurisdiction of the public service commission, and if exempt, an explanation of the exemption pursuant to 76-3-622, MCA.*

4.7.21 Sewage Treatment (Pg. 50)

All sewage treatment....

f. *For subdivisions with a shared, multiple user, or public wastewater treatment system the subdivider shall provide a statement of whether or not the system will be a public utility as defined in 69-3-101 and subject to the jurisdiction of the public service commission or exempt from jurisdiction of the public service commission, and if exempt, an explanation of the exemption pursuant to 76-3-622, MCA.*

RECREATION VEHICLE PARK: A lot, tract or parcel of land used or offered for use in whole or in part with or without charge for the parking of occupied recreational vehicles, ~~tents or similar devices~~ used for temporary living quarters for recreational camping or travel purposes. (Pg. 75)

SUBDIVISION: A division of land or land so divided which creates one or more parcels containing less than 160 acres that cannot be described as a one-quarter aliquot part of a United States government section, exclusive of public roadways, in order that the title to or possession of the parcels may be sold, ~~rented, leased,~~ or otherwise conveyed ~~transferred~~ and includes any re-subdivision and ~~furter~~ includes a condominium. ~~or area, which area, that provides or will provide multiple space for recreational camping vehicles or mobile homes~~ The term also means an area, regardless of its size, that provides or will provide multiple spaces for rent or lease on which recreational camping vehicles or mobile homes will be placed. The proposed revisions will ensure that the regulations comply with legislative changes to state law and will address inconsistencies in the regulations. ~~The revisions include changes to the procedures for extending preliminary plats, procedures for administrative approvals of first minor subdivisions, requirements for path easements, and requirements for showing topography on preliminary plats. The proposed revisions will correct inconsistencies in fees and depth to groundwater requirements.~~

The public hearing will be held on the **24<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2014 at 10:00 o'clock a.m.**, in the Office of the Board of Commissioners of Flathead County, Courthouse, 800 South Main Street Third Floor, Kalispell, Montana. *Flathead County Commissioners*

*Dear Council:*

*The reason for my meeting with you is to request a permanent access to our cabin at 665 Lodge Pole Drive, Marion Montana. This access has existed since 1952 and is the only real access to the property. When we purchased the property there were no covenants registered against it that would indicate the access would be taken away. The access has no impact on the boat launch and the size of the property restricts its possibilities for further development.*

*The boat launch is most frequently used by fisherman in the spring. After that the launch is used by residents of the lake to launch their boats for the summer and some servicing as required. There are some day users that come with their family load everyone in the boat and spend the day on the lake. July 4<sup>th</sup> is the busiest time and there can be 12-15 people parked randomly in the space which causes some issues. Some simple signage would minimize the issues. There are a few families that come and use the picnic area and either swim or fish or the public dock to boat from.*

*When we purchased the property there were 2 driveways, the one to the cabin and the other part way down on the south side of the lot. The south access is almost always blocked by people parking their vehicle after launching their boat. There are natural trees that limit the amount of space that can be utilized for parking on the lot. Another limiting factor to the launch area is the existing drainage ditch, it creates a natural barrier and people are reluctant to park in it. In the spring of the year and when we get down pours there is flowing water in it.*

*Council please consider our request for the granting of a permanent access to our cabin at 665 Lodge Pole Drive. It's a beautiful lake and our family is good stewards of the property and look forward to many years of enjoyment.*
