Cochran reviewed the following bi-monthly report with the commission.

#### **Ongoing Data Maintenance & Projects since our last (March) meeting**

- 22 COS's & 3 subdivision plats have been filed / drafted.
- We have worked 10 mobile home moving declarations.
- Address Improvement Program
  - 9 road naming/readdressing projects completed and 14 in progress
  - Addresses assigned per land owner request – 46
  - Addresses assigned via subdivision plat – 100
  - Addresses which were retired – 84
  - Addresses which were field validated - 50

#### **Map Orders & Special Projects since our last meeting**

- We have fulfilled requests for 1 map book, 35 maps & 28 ownership lists since our last meeting.
- Requests for GIS services have come from a variety of entities including several surveying companies and engineering firms, Badrock Fire Department, School District 6, School District 38, Columbia Falls Post Office, the City of Whitefish, the Commissioner's Office, Agency on Aging, County Attorney's Office, Road & Bridge, and the Election Department.
  - We printed 44 Section Maps for the Plat Room
  - We collaborated with Lincoln Chute to update the GIS data for the Wildland Urban Interface.
- Projects for the cities:
  - Updated Zoning on IMS website for both Kalispell and Whitefish
- GCDB – Geographic Coordinate Database. We have continued work to spatially adjust the GIS data for Homestead Entry Survey's (HES's).
- We completed researching all of the city annexations in the past 12 years to locate which roads are adjacent to the areas being annexed. We are awaiting direction from the county attorney on if we should put those roads in the city limits in the GIS data.
- We have completed our analysis to determine which roads meet the criteria for Fuel Tax Reimbursement from the MDOT. We identified 8.5 new miles of road this year, bringing the total to 2787 miles of road in Flathead County that meet the criteria for fuel tax reimbursement.
- We are working on updating the layers in our GIS library which come from outside data source.
- We have been working with Tamara in Finance on specific questions related to the tax audits.
- We have performed an audit of our mobile home data, comparing active T-Numbers in the Land System to what we have mapped in our database. Nate worked to identify, research, and correct 204 Inactive T-Numbers that were mapped in our data and 116 Active T-Numbers that were not mapped in our data.
- Nate also worked with Smith Valley Fire to map their fire hydrants for inclusion in a map book (a project that is still ongoing).

The property is located at 585 Conrad Point Road on Flathead Lake and there is approximately 150 feet of shoreline. The original permit was to construct a stone patio, wooden boardwalk and wooden retaining wall within the LPZ. The originally approved wooden boardwalk measured 32 feet in length by 5 feet in width. The applicant has requested an amendment to change the dimensions of the wooden boardwalk to measure 28 feet in length and 6 feet in width.

Moorman reported FLP 15-37 is a Lakeshore Construction Permit for property known as Volunteer Park in Lakeside. The applicant is proposing to bring in boulders, cobbles and gravel fill within the LPZ. Currently within the LPZ on the property there are several public docks, stone stairs, sidewalks, pathways, and retaining walls associated with Volunteer Park. The proposed work would consist of sinking boulders 2 to 4 feet in diameter for approximately 40 lineal feet near the stairs at the southern edge of the park. The work would also consist of placing approximately 4 cubic yards of cobble ranging from 3 inches to 6 inches in diameter, as well as 5 cubic yards of ¾ inch clean washed gravel and 5 cubic yards of 2 inch clean washed gravel to supplement the existing gravels. The applicant states the work is being requested to account for and prevent erosion that is undercutting portions of the sidewalk and stairs.

The buoy and any moored boat will adhere to the setbacks for buoy and boat swing in relation to the riparian property lines.
