#### Dear Flathead County Residents and Taxpayers:

As the end of my first year as Flathead County Superintendent of Schools rapidly comes to a close, I wanted to take this opportunity to express my gratitude for all the support this office has experienced over the past year. Flathead is blessed with knowledgeable, conscientious, hard-working elected officials and employees, and it is truly a privilege to serve among and with them.

Now, to the business at hand. Flathead County is also blessed with 23 exceptional public school districts where learning takes place and students are prepared for life after K-12 education. It doesn't happen by accident, and is due in large part to the hard work and dedication of the hundreds of excellent teachers and administrators at all of the county's institutions of learning. Education is an ever and rapidly evolving landscape that requires flexibility and innovation in order to not just keep up, but to be on the cutting edge in a very competitive global society. In my observations, and I have visited all of the districts, Flathead County schools are where they should be.

"Times are tough" is often a valid sentiment. Schools must be sensitive to taxpayer issues and are grateful for supportive communities that realize what schools must do to "keep up." Unfortunately, costs of doing that continue to shift from the federal and state governments to the local taxpayers. School districts, in turn, must continually seek efficiency in all operations. An unusual anomaly was created this year with the revised valuations. While the appraised (now called market values) were significantly increased in most districts, taxable valuations were reduced which forced most districts to levy more mills, which fortunately didn't result in significant increases in taxes for most tax payers. The new formula adopted by the legislature should alleviate some of the fluctuations and create more stability.

Each year the County Superintendent's Office collects and compiles factual data from our schools so that we might provide information to those of you interested in school finances. Figures are taken from the previous year-end financial reports (2014-2015), the current-year school district budgets (2015-2016), and the current-year enrollment data (October, 2016).
