Dear Flathead County Residents and Taxpayers:

As the end of my sixth year as Flathead County Superintendent of Schools comes to a close, I find with each passing year I appreciate working with the knowledgeable, conscientious, hard-working elected officials and employees of Flathead County more each year. It is truly a blessing to have the opportunity to live in the Last Best Place and serve the people of Flathead County.

On another note, nobody could have predicted what happened this year. All of the schools in the county closing down in March in response to the COVID 19 pandemic, which seemed to ebb through the summer and then reemerged with a vengeance in the fall. All of the schools in the county have done a heroic job in trying to keep their doors open for in person learning although there have been some setbacks.

Flathead County is blessed with 23 excellent public school districts where learning takes place and students are preparing for life after K-12 education. It doesn't happen by accident and is due in large part to the hard work and dedication of the hundreds of excellent teachers and administrators at all of the county's institutions of learning. Especially during this unusual year due to the pandemic, the business of educating our youth has had to evolve, and no stone has been left unturned in developing flexibility, innovation, and creativity just to continue to provide educational services. It has not been perfect, but districts have gone to great lengths and asked a lot of teaching staffs in order to do the very best they can to try to keep their doors open and provide a safe learning environment for staff and students.

Schools must be sensitive to taxpayer issues and are grateful for supportive communities that realize what schools must do to "keep up." School districts, in turn, must continually seek efficiency in all operations. One sign that financial stability is improving has been the overwhelming support for major bond issues in Bigfork, Kalispell, Somers, Whitefish, and Columbia Falls over the past few years. These bond issues have brought about increases in property taxes—in some cases significant increases—but it is apparent that a majority of citizens and taxpayers realize the value of education and high quality school facilities and that they are willing to pay for them in order to keep area schools on the cutting edge.

Each year the County Superintendent's Office collects and compiles factual data from our schools so that we might provide information to those of you interested in school finances. Figures are taken from the prior year-end financial reports (2019-2020), the current-year school district budgets (2020-2021), and the fall enrollment data (October, 2020).
