#### Dear Flathead County Residents and Taxpayers:

As the end of my second year as Flathead County Superintendent of Schools rapidly comes to a close, I wanted to again take the opportunity to express my gratitude for all the support this office has experienced over the past two years. Flathead County is blessed with knowledgeable, conscientious, hard-working elected officials and employees, and it is truly a privilege to serve among and with them.

Now, to the business at hand. Flathead County is also blessed with 23 exceptional public school districts where learning takes place and students are prepared for life after K-12 education.
