CHECKLIST FOR CANADIAN/FOREIGN VEHICLES

(MT STATE REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTERING A VEHICLE PURCHASED IN CANADA)

- 1. If vehicle is new original **NVIS form** accompanied by a **notarized bill of sale.** If vehicle is used original **Canadian Registration** properly released by registered owner. If not released, then needs to be accompanied by a **notarized bill of sale**.
 - A. **Notarized Bill of Sale** needs to be signed by the seller or selling dealer. Bill of sale needs to include: year, make, model, vehicle identification number, and date.
 - 2. Vehicle/Vessel Identification Number Inspection Certificate.
 - 3. **Customs Entry Documents** (original, photocopy, or fax is acceptable) make sure it is stamped
 - 4. **Odometer Statement** signed by both seller/dealer and customer. Only required for vehicle nine years old and newer.
 - 5. **Application for Montana Title** which can be filled out at the Motor Vehicle Department.
 - 6. **HS7** If vehicle is *non-conforming* (box 3 on declaration checked) then the **NHTSA Bond Release Letter** is also required.
