Summary of Diseases in the State of Montana for Week 15:

- Antimicrobial Resistant Organisms: Carbapenemase-producing organism (CPO), Clinical (1)
- Enteric Diseases: Campylobacteriosis (5), Cryptosporidiosis (1), Giardiasis (2), Salmonellosis (2)
- General Communicable Diseases: COVID-19 (108), Coccidioidomycosis (2)
- Heavy Metal Exposures: Lead (4)
- Hepatitis: Hepatitis B, chronic (2), Hepatitis C, acute (1), Hepatitis C, chronic (15)
- STD/HIV: Chlamydia (76), Gonorrhea (13), HIV/AIDS (1), Syphilis, latent (7), Syphilis, primary or secondary (1)
- Vaccine Preventable Diseases: Influenza, hospitalization or death (1), Streptococcus pneumoniae, invasive (5)
- Zoonotic: Rabies, post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) (1)
