Summary of Diseases in the State of Montana for Week 45

- Enteric Diseases: Campylobacteriosis (6), Cryptosporidiosis (1), Giardiasis (4), Salmonellosis (4), Shiga toxin-producing Escherichia coli (STEC) (1), Shigellosis (1), Vibriosis (1)
- General Communicable Diseases: COVID-19 (590), Latent TB Infection (LTBI) (4)
- Heavy Metal Exposures: Lead (4)
- Hepatitis: Hepatitis B, chronic (1), Hepatitis C, acute (2), Hepatitis C, chronic (13)
- STD/HIV: Chlamydia (75), Gonorrhea (9), Syphilis, primary and secondary (5), Syphilis, latent (2)
- Vaccine Preventable Diseases: Influenza hospitalization or death (1), Pertussis (4), Streptococcus pneumoniae, invasive (1)
- Zoonotic: Rabies, post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) (3)

## **Hunting Safety**

### Practice Good Hand Hygiene

- · Don't eat, drink, or smoke while dressing game or fowl
- · Wear gloves if possible when field dressing
- · Wash your hands with soap and water after handing wild game
- · If you don't have access to soap and water, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer

## Food Safety

- Avoid eating raw or undercooked meat
- Any uncooked game should be promptly frozen, refrigerated or disposed of properly
