


72-HOUR NO CONTACT ORDERS

Consistent with Mont. Code Ann. §45-5-209, the Montana Eleventh Judicial District Court Judges, the Flathead County Justices of the Peace, Kalispell Municipal Court, Whitefish Municipal Court, and Columbia Falls City Court hereby direct law enforcement and peace officers to serve a *72-Hour No Contact Order* on all defendants charged with or arrested for Aggravated Assault (if victim is a partner or family member), Partner or Family Member Assault, Assault with a Weapon (if victim is a partner or family member) or Strangulation of a Partner or Family Member. Mont. Code Ann. §45-5-209(1). A copy of the *72-Hour No Contact Order* is attached.





The Flathead County District Court Judges, Justices of the Peace, and Judges of Kalispell Municipal Court, Whitefish Municipal Court, and Columbia Falls City Court have issued a Standing Order directing law enforcement and peace officers to serve this *72-Hour No Contact Order* on all defendants charged with or arrested for Aggravated Assault (if victim is a partner or family member), Partner or Family Member Assault, Assault with a Weapon (if victim is a partner or family member) or Strangulation of a Partner or Family Member. Mont. Code Ann. §45-5-209. You have been charged with or arrested for _____. You are not allowed to have contact with the following protected persons:

This means you may not contact the protected person(s) either in person, by a third party, by telephone, by electronic means, or in writing. You must also stay at least 1,500 feet away from the protected person, which includes the protected person's residence if the address is listed above.

Violation of this 72-Hour No Contact Order is a criminal offense under §45-5-209, MCA, and may result in your arrest. You may be arrested even if the person protected by the 72-Hour No Contact Order invites or allows you to violate the prohibitions. This order lasts 72 hours or until the court continues or changes the order.
