### Summary of Diseases in the State of Montana for Week 6:

- **Enteric Diseases:** Campylobacteriosis (8), Giardiasis (1), Salmonellosis (2), Shiga toxin-producing Escherichia coli (STEC) (1)
- **General Communicable Diseases:** COVID-19 (454), Latent TB Infection (LTBI) (3), Streptococcal toxic-shock syndrome (1)
- **Heavy Metal Exposures:** Lead (3)
- **Hepatitis:** Hepatitis B, chronic (1), Hepatitis C, chronic (17)
- **STD/HIV:** Chlamydia (85), Gonorrhea (14), Syphilis, congenital (1), Syphilis, primary and secondary (3), Syphilis, latent (13)
- **Vaccine Preventable Diseases:** Influenza, hospitalization or death (22), Streptococcus pneumoniae, invasive (2), Varicella (1)
- **Zoonotic and Vector borne:** Rabies, post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) (2)
