Summary of Diseases in the State of Montana for Week 2:

- Enteric Diseases: Campylobacteriosis (5), Cryptosporidiosis (1), Giardiasis (3), Shiga toxin-producing Escherichia coli (STEC) (2)
- General Communicable Diseases: Coccidioidomycosis (1), COVID-19 (680), Latent TB Infection (LTBI) (3), Legionellosis (1), Tuberculosis (1)
- Heavy Metal Exposures: Lead (3)
- Hepatitis: Hepatitis C, chronic (19)
- STD/HIV: Chlamydia (45), Gonorrhea (12), Syphilis, primary and secondary (6), Syphilis, latent (11)
- Vaccine Preventable Diseases: Influenza, hospitalization or death (72), Streptococcus pneumoniae, invasive (3)
- Zoonotic: Rabies, post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) (3)
