Narrative/Discussion:

1. We received a total of \$14,307.52 from payments through Pintler Billing during January. This total includes insurance, Medicare, Medicaid, and patient payments. Patient adjustments were \$10,569.75 for January. We billed \$21,642.30 during the month of January. We currently have \$47,977.39 in A/R. This includes insurance, Medicare, Medicaid, and patient responsibilities. This amount does not include our patient accounts that have been sent to collections.
2. We should be receiving our Flathead County EMS Levy distribution this month. Total for the last 6 months was approximately \$13,857.07
3. We have \$36,661.24 currently active in collections.
4. We have 3 past due patient accounts from Pintler asking if we want to pursue with collections or write off.
5. Currently working on the schedule for an EMR class for our new members and a couple of our existing members. Tentatively looking at March – beginning of April.
